
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Coupes felled due to the removal of DNB infected Lodgepole pine. Restock programmed following fallow period.

Coupes that were previously to be managed by LISS have now been designated for clearfell and restocking as the site conditions and current crop are not suitable for LISS management.

Coupe left isolated with no access due to AWPR. This will be managed by minimum intervention.

Coupe around car park is starting to become unstable with some windblow. Area to be felled in first phase.
