



Torinturk Issues and Objectives Map: Accessible Text

To be read clockwise around the map:

- **Roading and access** – Good network of in forest roads, maintain and keep accessible. Severely restricted and consultation routes, see TTMP B8024 Kilberry Loop Road – Ormsary – North to A83 Inverneill plan.
- **Coupes** – Ensure that coupes relate to landscape character and scenic quality. Scale, shape and plan coupes to maximise cost efficiencies for felling, access provision and re-establishment effectiveness.
- **Ancient Woodland Sites (AWS)** – Identify, protect and enhance AWS. Restore PAWS sites.
- **Atlantic Rainforest** – Proactively manage and restore Atlantic Rainforest. Measures include rhododendron control.
- **Larch** – Develop a programme to remove most of the larch in phase 1 or phase 2, if phase 1 not feasible.
- **Private Water Supplies** – Protect drinking water and enhance riparian corridors.
- **Community and landowners** – Ensure liaison and consultation.
- **Heritage features** – Local and Scheduled Monuments. Ensure features are protected.
- **Recreation** – Maintain suitable community and visitor walking access where appropriate.
- **Core paths** – Core path C295 (Inverneill to Tarbert via Kilberry NCN) – follows route of B8024 through the block. A second core path C106 (Torinturk circular, Giants grave and Dun) has a short loop within the visitor zone in the south-east of the block. Ensure operations don't affect core paths and they remain open.
- **Utilities** – Protect infrastructure and ensure correct buffers.
- **Wetland habitats** – Restore and maintain areas of bog/wetland habitat where appropriate, and other priority/protected species and habitats. Select suitable tree species for soil type.
- **Tree species** – Diversify the forest block in terms of age and species as appropriate.
- **Timber** – Maintain sustainable quality timber production.
- **Deer management** – Provide opportunity for appropriate and effective deer management and integration with neighbouring landowner deer management.
- **Local Landscape Area** – Local Landscape Area covers western edge of block. Maintain and enhance views.
- **FLS fencing** – Ensure appropriate and maintained as required.
