Buzzard's Nest Car Park will close and become a part of the Forest Holidays site, once new trails are developed around Glentress Peel as part of the Masterplan

New Forest Holidays Cabin Site to be developed 2022 - 2024

Venlaw Wood is a quiet wood with no formal trails, used mainly by local walkers,

Glentress is a forest for mountain biking, walking, horse riding and mountain bike events. It is the flagship 7 Stanes mountain biking centre, with over 60kms of graded trails and many unofficial trails.

Go Ape High Ropes Adventure

Glentress Peel is the main visitor hub for Tweed Valley Forest Park, with parking, toilets, visitor information, cafe, bike hire and wildlife viewing.

The Glentress Masterplan will see facilities upgraded with new and improved trails, new mountain bike taster trails and skills park, a new multi-user path and improved parking. Work will take place 2022 - 2024.

Cademuir car park and trailhead

Kirkburn car park, picnic site, toilets and trailhead

Cademuir is a popular local forest for walking, horse riding, mountain biking and events. Within the southern area, unauthorised MTB trails are managed using FLS and NAF guidance. The northern part is quieter, with formal walking trails.

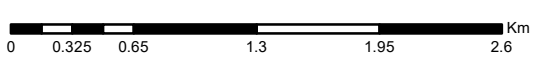
Cardrona is a quieter forest, mainly for walking and horse riding, with mountain biking limited to existing forest roads and tracks.
