Lossie forest is located on the coast, facing the North Sea.

The River Lossie runs along the Western boundary of the forest.

There are many World War II defences in Lossie that are now scheduled monuments.

A wide area of the forest is classified as a Special Site of Scientific Interest (SSSI) and a Special Area of Conservation (SAC).

There is a car park in the South West of the forest which is well used by the public.

A gravel quarry is located in the center of the forest

Some of the soils are mainly composed of Shingle ridges which are also now priority habitats.



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
