The popular West Highland Way (approx. 80,000 users per year) passes to the East of Auch block, and through the corner of the Bridge of Orchy block. Users have a prolonged view of the forest for about an hour

Previous LMP looked at leasing other areas for grazing - is this going ahead?

Two small grazing agreements ended 2010?

The Drinking Water Protected Area for Dalmally just clips the forest block

Most of the deer fence round Glen Orchy is of excellent or good quality?

Fences what happens here?

Whole length of minor public road in Glen Orchy is an excluded route for timber traffic.

Major flooding of River Orchy flood plain may affect access and lower slopes of Glen Orchy

Deer fence is poor or non-existent along base of Glen Orchy

What is the boundary here? Access to something?

Hydro agreement and access agreement ended 2015?

Community of Dalmally close by.....

Flooding of river...

Powerlines pass through Succoth, potentially isolating coupes from the forest roads.

Most of the deer fence round Succoth is of excellent or good quality??

Part of Succoth forest block comes within the Potentially Vulnerable Area (PVA) of Succoth, but is a small enough percentage of the total area to have minimal effect on flooding.

Fences what happens here?

Recent hydro scheme is still a bit raw.

Wind is funnelled along Glen Lochy and has caught the exposed western coupe edges

Agreement for Hydro Scheme (Closed) says it ends in 2054

Main train line passes through plantation and has been hampered by windblow

The Potentially Vulnerable Area (PVA) for flooding and drinking water for Tyndrum falls just outwith the LMP area.

The A85 gives prolonged views along the length of Glen Lochy

The railway line passes through the South edge of Glen Lochy, isolating some coupes between the railway line and river

Popular route to Ben Lui and other tops passes through the forest and will provide views the length of Glen Lochy during the ascent/descent.

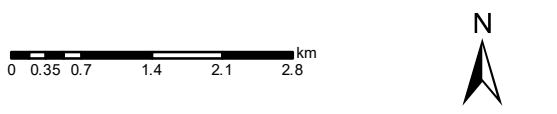

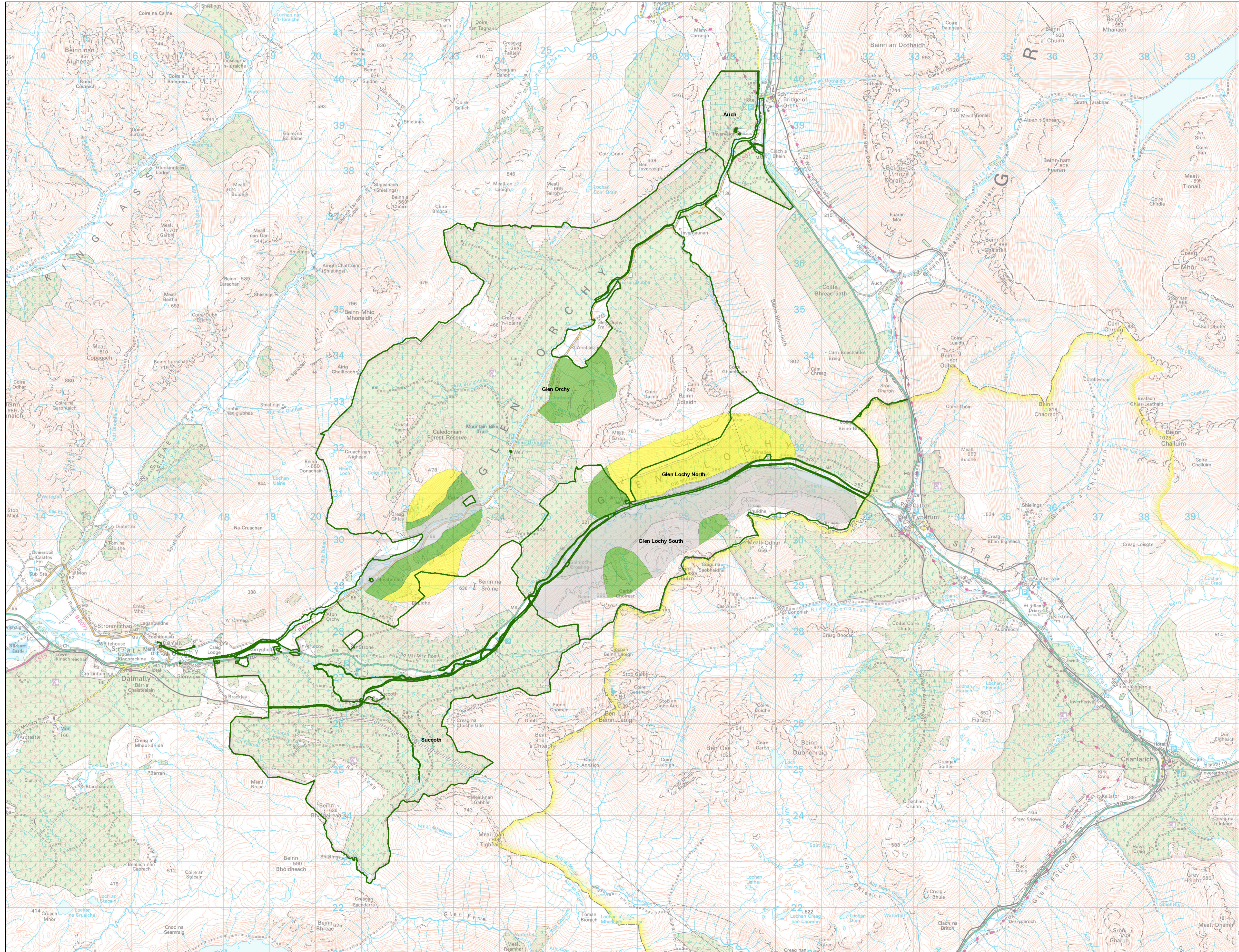
