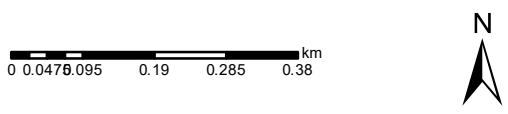

Proposed species

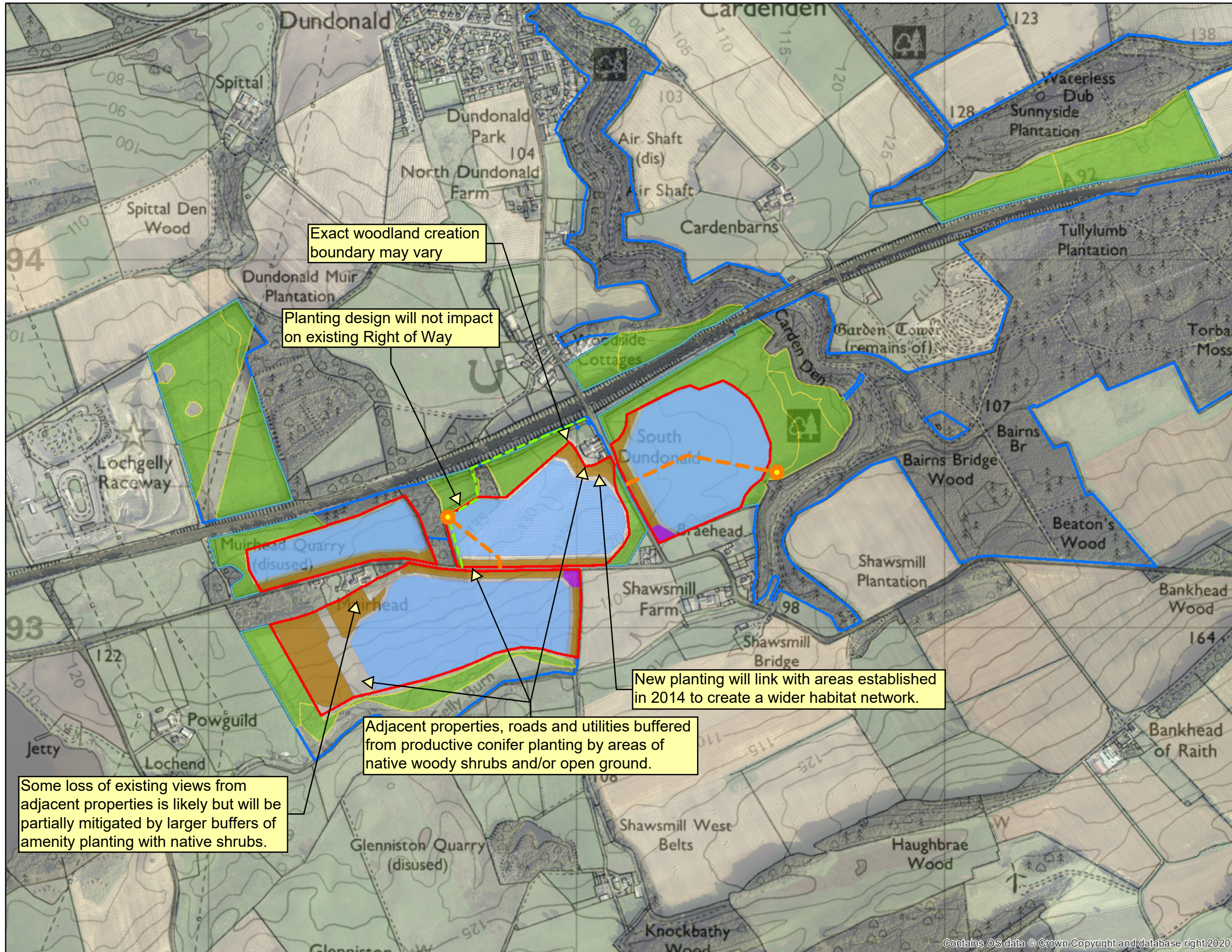
- Norway spruce (& Douglas fir)

Planting design will not impact on existing Right of Way

New planting will link with areas established in 2014 to create a wider habitat network.

Adjacent properties, roads and utilities buffered from productive conifer planting by areas of native woody shrubs and/or open ground.

Some loss of existing views from adjacent properties is likely but will be partially mitigated by larger buffers of amenity planting with native shrubs.
