How to get here

For Lochan na Dunaich Trail:

From Strontian, take the A816 west for about 9 miles (14.5 km). Lochan na Dunaich car park is on the right hand side. If you reach the junction with the B8007 to Salen, you've gone about 250 yards too far!

For Sàilean nan Cuileag:

From Strontian, take the A816 west for about 8 miles (13 km). Sàilean nan Cuileag car park is on the left.

Trail Information



Sàilean nan Cuileag ●●●

Wind down through the Atlantic oakwoods and mossy boulders to the atmospheric lochside bay. The salt marsh here on the edge of Loch Sunart supports many unusual wild flowers.

A steep and narrow path with a rough and rocky surface, with some steep steps. Can be muddy after rain.

Lochan na Dunaich Trail ●●●

A short wander through the open oakwoods to brooding Lochan na Dunaich, said to be haunted by a kelpie (or water spirit).

Firm but uneven gravel surface throughout. Generally flat with some short moderate slopes. Includes sections of wooden boardwalk.
